A Study in Jeremiah: Standing Tall, Part 2

Pray

Read Jeremiah 7:1-24

1. If you were to attend a church for the first time this Sunday, what would you consider to be some positives of their worship?

What would you consider to be some negatives of their worship?

2. In their hypocrisy, they tried to try to include the true Jehovah God in their worship. They just brought their idols into the temple of God and made Jehovah one of the many gods they worshiped. In what ways do we do that same thing today?

3. Read Exodus 20:3 “Anything that we put before God becomes an idol.” Discuss.

4. Read Jeremiah 7:3-4. “Worship that is not from the heart is worthless.” Discuss.

5. Read Jeremiah 29:13 and Deuteronomy 6:5

“What God is interested in is a change of the heart. And when our heart changes, there is always life-change.” Discuss.

6. Let this be a warning: Sometimes it’s too late to pray

Read Jeremiah 7:16. Discuss.

7. “When a nation starts to fall apart, it begins in the home.”

Read Jeremiah 7:17-18. Discuss.

8. Only in Christianity is God’s grace given through God’s justice. In Christ, mercy and justice are NOT at odds with each other but they come together as one. God chose to give His grace and His justice at the same time at the cross.

Read Romans 3:24-26. Discuss

9. “Sacrifices mean nothing if your heart is unfaithful to God.”

God wants obedience before sacrifice. Read 1 Samuel 15:22. Discuss.

10. “Worship God from your heart and obey Him because He has a plan to give you a future and a hope.” Read Jeremiah 29:11. Discuss.
