6. Read Ephesians 1:17

How do you see the trinity at work in this verse?

7. Read Ephesians 1:18

Describe the “biblical heart”.

8. Read Psalm 44:21 and 1 Samuel 16:7

What do these verses say to you?

9. Read Proverbs 4:23 (NIV)

Everything you do, the way you treat yourself, your relationship with God, your relationships with each other, all flow from your heart. Discuss.

10. Read Ephesians 1:18

What is the hope of our calling?
