1. Read Luke 10:38-42 (Christian Standard Bible)
2. The most important safety feature of all has been on your car all along. It's your \_\_\_\_\_.

9. Worship is the very heart of the Christian Life. Worship is the motivation for all that we are and all that we do in Christ. What does that mean to you?
10. Read John 4:24. True worship of God requires from the worshipper: humility, reverence, honor and adoration. Describe those four words.
11. Understanding who God is will shape our worship. Explain.
12. Worship does not begin and end with the singing in church. Worship of God is so much more than singing. True worship is not determined by our musical ability, or how sincere we are or how emotional we get or how many hands are raised. True worship is determined by God.
13. Read Isaiah 29:13. It's not so much about what happens on our outside. True worship comes from our inside. What does that mean to you?
14. We get all hung up about music style. God is so much less interested in the style and so much more interested in our heart. Discuss.
15. Read Luke 10:39. Some people think that Christians have to choose between Mary and Martha. Which one is best?
16. Read Luke 10:40. What does it mean to "lose your joy of serving"?
17. Read Luke 10:41. If serving God makes us hard to live with, something's wrong. Discuss.
